REMOTE ACCESS	
	3.500.000 CPU hours
Offer for 2014	At least 20% of the CPU time is reserved for long-term activities initiated in previous periods. If there are not enough applications to cover this minimum, the remainder will be added to the overall offer.
Period of access	April 1 <sup>st</sup> 2014 - December 31 <sup>st</sup> 2014.
Access limits	Maximum of 800.000 CPU hours for the period.
Additional requirements.	No additional requirements to those specified in the general rules for access in 2014.
Applications deadline	February 26, 2014.
Evaluation and selection	In the event of a draw, alphabetical order will stating with <b>"A"</b> , following the official Resolution of February 6 <sup>th</sup> 2013 from the Department of Internal Affairs (BOE n <sup>o</sup> 37 12/02/2013).
	Researchers belonging to the Galician public research system, or CSIC, have remote access for free.
Funding	The cost of operation, maintenance and support will be measured in terms of CPU hours. More information: https://www.cesga.es/en/servicios/computacion/horas-calculo#Tarifas
	CESGA will consider the possibility of financing the proposals rated as excellent, even if there is non specific funding available for it. Proposal will be considered excellent if it obtains a score over 4.5 on the evaluation process.

Offer for 2014	<b>4</b> research stays
Period of access	<b>April 1<sup>st</sup> 2014 - December 31<sup>st</sup> 2014.</b>
Access limits	From 1 to <b>8 weeks</b> . Up to <b>10.000 hours of CPU</b> for access, the need of use must be justified.
Additional requirements.	No additional requirements to those specified in the general rules for access in 2014.
Applications deadline	February 26, 2014.
Evaluation and selection	In the event of a draw, alphabetical order will stating with " <b>A</b> ", following the official Resolution of February $6^{th}$ 2013 from the Department of Internal Affairs (BOE n <sup>o</sup> 37 12/02/2013).
Funding	Researchers belonging to the Galician public research system, or CSIC, have access to hours of computation for free. Funding for other type of access costs (travel, accommodation, boarding, etc) does not depend on the applicant's institution and those expenses will be borne by the beneficiary.
